**Fire Inspection to take place at Sharon in June** – Sharon Mennonite will be scheduled for a routine fire inspection in June. If you are in charge of a storage area, classroom, or meeting space in the church, please ensure that your area meets the following requirements:

- Thirty-six inch wide path to all exit doors must be kept clear
- Storage must be contained so that nothing capable of burning is within two feet of the ceiling
- Thirty-six inches of clear space must be maintained around furnaces, water heaters, heat producing appliances, and any fuse/breaker panel
- All flammable liquids must be identified and stored in their original containers
- Remove any electrical overload, extension cords, and multi-plug adaptors

Please help our trustees ensure that we are able to pass our inspection without issue.
