Sunday Morning Worship Update – This week, June 28, we will continue worshipping outdoors (weather permitting.) If inclement weather is present, a live stream service will be done. Starting July 5th, worship will begin to move indoors. Every other row will be roped off in the interest of maintaining social distance. We encourage seating in family units, maintaining six feet between each unit. There will be no greeters during this time, and ushers will be present to take the offering (ushers will take offering, the offering baskets will not be passed). Attendance will continue to be taken for contact tracing, should it be needed in the future. Masks will continue to be made available for those who would like one (masks are encouraged but not required.) Additional information regarding dismissal procedure will be forthcoming.

Children's Hour – Children's Hour will now move to one time per month on the second Sunday of each month. Meeting time will remain at 6:00 pm.

2020 Church Auction – The church auction team was able to connect recently via email and have made the decision to delay the Church Auction that was to take place this fall. The group will begin efforts to develop a plan of action to get another date set. We appreciate your understanding and support in this time of unknown.

Pastor Jared's Sabbatical - After some prayer and discernment, and conversation with the leadership team, Pastor Jared has decided to delay his entire sabbatical until the 2021 calendar year. This decision is in response to the COVID pandemic and the unknown surrounding the eventual return to normal church activities. He is still working out an anticipated schedule and will communicate that in addition to a plan for the sabbatical as it becomes clearer.

Pathfinders Sunday school class – **UPDATE :** The Pathfinders Sunday school class will now be meeting online from 8:30-9:30 a.m. via GoToMeeting (<https://www.gotomeet.me/JaredChase>) in order to accommodate travel time to the church for services. All are welcome to join the class!

Sunday Morning Worship – As we return to meeting in person at the church, we will continue recording services to upload to YouTube (<https://www.youtube.com/channel/UC0ZMhB3Q1vSjtah1JgqfP5A>) so that those who may not feel comfortable attending in person will have the ability to worship with us on Sunday. We will continue to send a Worship Guide to the congregation via email on Friday afternoons prior to the service.

Church Office – Pastoral staff and the church administrative assistant will be available via phone for any needs that may arise. For those with a pastoral care concern outside of normal church hours, contact Pastor Jared or Pastor Walter. The office administrator will be available via phone and will be in the office on Fridays to handle administrative tasks that cannot be performed remotely.

Vacation Bible School and Work Camp – Given the current guidelines for worship, the decision has been made that Vacation Bible School and Work Camp will not be held this summer. The Work Camp Committee is hoping to have a day of service in late July. More information will follow.
